Summary: Discover an exhibition, curated by students from The Courtauld Institute of Art,

which seeks to narrate stories in surprising and exciting ways. This exhibition forms the core project of The Courtauld's MA programme, *Curating the Art Museum*. Drawing on eight major series of prints, drawings and watercolours from The Courtauld Gallery and five works from the Arts Council Collection, the

exhibition features over 100 pieces.

Institute of Art's MA Curating the Art Museum programme which this year has

eleven students from the UK, Europe and the United States.

How to get there: Nearest underground stations: Temple, Covent Garden, Charing Cross and

Embankment Stations. Overground to Waterloo, Charing Cross or Blackfriars. Buses servicing the Strand include numbers 6, 9, 11, 13, 15, 23, 77a, 91 and 176, while the River Bus Service can be taken to Embankment and Savoy piers. Pedestrian access to Somerset House is available from Victoria Embankment,

Waterloo Bridge (via a new footbridge link) or from the Strand.
